



Figure1. Safe operating area




Figure2. Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Figure3. Output characteristics




Figure4. Transfer characteristics




Figure5. Static drain-source on resistance




Figure6. RDS(ON) vs Junction Temperature




Figure7.  $BV_{DSS}$  vs Junction Temperature




Figure8. Maximum  $I_D$  vs Junction Temperature




Figure9. Gate charge waveforms




Figure10. Capacitance



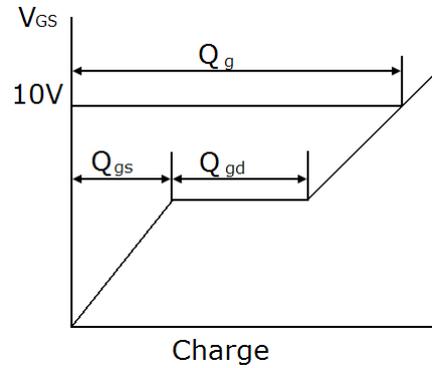
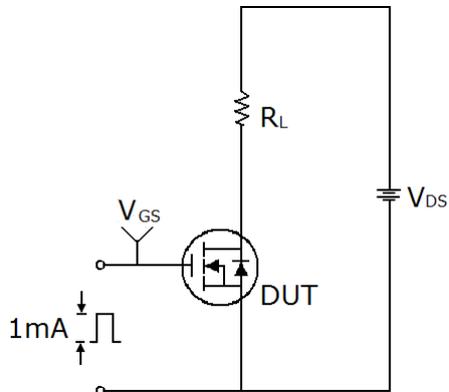


Figure11. Transient Thermal Impedance






### 1) Gate charge test circuit & Waveform



### 2) Switch Time Test Circuit:




### 3) Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




